#### RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14 requires all municipalities in the State of New Jersey to adopt a cash management plan that is subject to the annual audit;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Borough of Tavistock that the following requirements shall be adhered to:

The Borough Governing Body shall annually designate the legal depositories for all municipal funds. The resolution may be amended of supplemented from time to time as the Borough Governing Body deems necessary. Such resolution shall be deemed a part of the cash management plan.

The Borough Governing Body shall annually establish by resolution adopted at its annual reorganization meeting the required signatories to the municipal bank accounts.

All municipal funds received by any official or employee shall be either deposited within 48 hours to an interest bearing account in the name of the Borough of Tavistock, or shall be turned over to the treasurer within 48 hours of receipt.

All revenues received by the Municipal Clerk, Chief Financial Officer and Tax Collector shall be deposited to interest bearing accounts in the legal depositories.

No municipal funds shall be disbursed prior to approval of the Borough Governing Body except for debt service payments, investments, payroll turnovers to agencies and discount vouchers. Debt service payments and discount vouchers must be ratified after payments.

It shall be the responsibility of the Chief Financial Officer to analyze the cash flow and to invest funds in legal investments so as to maximize interest earnings. When investing funds in commercial banks, savings banks, savings and loans, etc., the treasurer shall obtain a minimum of three quotations and shall invest at the institution offering the highest effective rate. The Chief Financial Officer shall determine which type of legal investment will best serve the needs of the municipality and is authorized to place the funds in any such legal investment, unless otherwise restricted by the Governing Body. The Chief Financial Officer shall report monthly all investment transactions as required by N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15.2 to the Governing Body.
