AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH CAMDEN COUNTY RELATIVE TO PROJECT SAVE

WHEREAS the Commissioners of the Borough of Tavistock are aware that a large number of the individuals who appear in Municipal Court on a recurring basis are there because of crimes committed due to a drug problem; and

WHEREAS the Commissioners further understands that a cooperative approach needs to be implemented to get these repeat offenders into treatment rather than incarceration; and

WHEREAS the Camden County Board of Freeholders implemented Project Save, a voluntary substance abuse treatment referral and intervention strategy for municipal court defendants arrested for non-violent crimes, as a pilot program in 2019; and

WHEREAS the Project Save Program offers the participating entities an effective and efficient means of providing these services and has been determined to be a great success; and

WHEREAS, Camden County is continuing the Project Save program for another three years and municipalities in Camden County can continue to avail themselves of these services by entering into a shared service agreement with Camden County; and

WHEREAS all of the costs associated with this program will be borne by the County for the duration of this agreement; and

WHEREAS the Commissioners understand the benefits of this program and intends to continue to participate in the Project Save Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Borough of Tavistock, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that entering into a shared service with Camden County relative to the Project Save Program is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute said agreement.
