The following Core Competencies and Best Practice questions were answered no for the following reasons:

- The Borough does not have a Storm Recovery Trust Reserve (Q7)
- The Borough does not use a scoring system to determine capital projects (Q10)
- Borough does not have a charging station installed on borough property (Q19)
- No formal Investment Policy to prepare cash flow analysis (Q30)
- The Borough has not adopted a more stringent policy for CTC Surety Bond (Q31)
- The Borough has an anti-nepotism policy in the personnel manual but not through an ordinance (Q47)

To receive a full December state aid payment, we would need to score at least twenty-nine (29) points. Tavistock's score is 38.50 points and will not lose any 2023 state aid.
